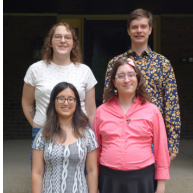

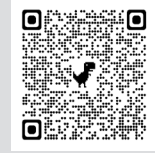

IndyGo bus station work on Meridian Street has begun.

IndyGo is making upgrades and improvements to Red Line bus stations, enhancement work on the stations along Meridian Street at 30th, 34th, and 38th Streets. This work will include bus pad reinforcement and concrete pouring that will continue through late June. Access to Trinity from Meridian Street will be limited during this time. **Cross Streets at 32nd and 34th are still open.** Plan to use Pennsylvania Street to 33rd Street to access the parking lot.
