

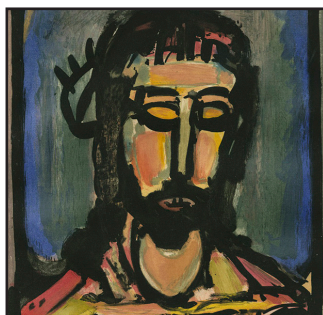

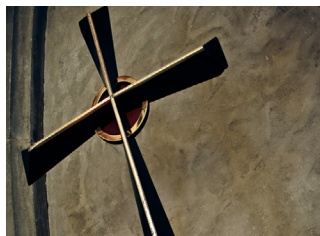
#### Clapham Circle | St. Benedict House | 12:30pm
