## Dinner Church



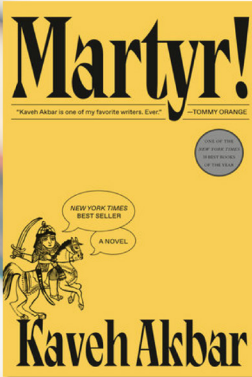
